 - Study title, Author names & Contact info of presenting author, Affiliations. Abstract content must include:
 - Background, Aim, Objectives, Methodology, Results, Discussion, Conclusion & Keywords
- Maximum word count for the abstract: 250 words. Format requirements:
 - Font: Times New Roman
 - Title: Font size 14
 - Remaining text: Font size 12
- Only one presenter is allowed per abstract.
- Specify "Oral" or "Poster" presentation at the top right corner of the abstract.

Oral Presentation:

- Maximum 15 slides.
- Mention "Pharmacy 4.0" along with the assigned code and number at the bottom center of each slide.
- Presentation time: 7 minutes for the talk, 3 minutes for questions.
- Final presentation must be submitted by **9th April 2025**
- Bring an extra copy of the presentation on a USB drive.

Poster Presentation:

- Poster size: 120x90 cm.
- Presenters must bring all required materials and set up the poster in their assigned space. Mention "Pharmacy 4.0" and the assigned code and number at the bottom of the poster.
